This quilt was specifically designed to use charm squares. I know you will enjoy making this beautiful quilt.

Fabric requirements:

- 4 packages of charm squares with 42 pieces in each pack (I used Dominique II by Moda)
- 3 yards aged muslin or any light background for the pieced blocks
- 5/8 yard tone-on-tone red for pieced stars and 1st border
- 1 yard tone-on-tone brown for pieced stars and 2nd border
- 1 fat quarter solid black for center of stars
- 3 yards for outer border fabric and binding
- 5 yards of backing fabric

Supplies needed for class:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- 1/4" seam guide and/or presser foot
- basic sewing supplies
- 6 1/2" square ruler, 12" or longer ruler
- Tucker Trimmer (optional but a very useful tool when making hourglass blocks)
- iron/portable ironing surface
- rotary cutter/mat

Pre-cutting instructions:

- Cut all your charm squares into 2" x 5" strips
- Background fabric: cut 13 strips, 5" x 42"; subcut into 240, 2" x 5" strips
- The star blocks will be cut in class.
